As part of Orange County Mayor Teresa Jacobs' INVEST In Our Home for Life program, \$20 million has been allotted for the development of new parks or the improvement of existing parks and facilities.



On Friday, April 28 at 9 a.m., Mayor Teresa Jacobs and District 5 Commissioner Emily Bonilla will host the **ground breaking** for the 5,000-square-foot East Orange District Park Recreation Center, 22023 E. Colonial Drive, Christmas.



On Wednesday, May 10 at 3:30 p.m., Mayor Jacobs and District 1 Commissioner Betsy VanderLey will host the **ground breaking** for Deputy Scott Pine Community Park, 17199 Ficquette Road, Windermere. This site will feature the Windermere High School stadium and two multi-purpose fields. Deputy Pine was killed in the line of duty in 2014.
