Beat the Summer Heat at Our Pool and Splash Pads!

With the temperature climbing over 95 degrees in Orange County almost every day, you, your family and friends can find cool relief at Orange County Parks and Recreation's five splash pads and Fort Gatlin Recreation Complex's pool.



Fort Gatlin's pool has open swimming Monday through Friday, noon to 6 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Cost is \$2 per person per visit or buy an annual pass for \$60 per person. Splash pads at Barnett, Bithlo and Capehart Parks are free. Splash pads at Downey and Dr. Phillips Community Parks charge \$1 per person per session. Groups of 10 or more must pre-register with the
