## HOW TO USE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

## **FACE COVERINGS**



- Wearing face coverings is an additional public-health measure people should take to reduce the spread of COVID-19. The CDC recommends social distancing, frequent hand cleaning and other everyday preventive actions.
- Procedure style, ear-loop masks may be re-worn multiple times, but not cleaned.
- Avoid heavy makeup or other personal-care products around the face.
- Replace your mask if it is torn, wet or dirty.

## **HAND SANITIZER**



- The CDC recommends washing hands with soap and water, whenever possible. If soap and water are not available, using a hand sanitizer can help avoid the spread of germs.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Apply the product to the palm of one hand, and rub the product all over the surfaces of your hands until your hands are dry.
