



Should I Enter DROP or Retire Without DROP?

If you are uncertain if you want to enter DROP or retire without entering DROP, please follow the steps below to help you make an informed decision:

2. Call FRS at 844-377-1888, Option 3, to request a comparative estimate/calculation of your benefit options (DROP or retire without DROP).
3. After you receive your comparative estimate/calculation from FRS and have reviewed the information outlined above, you should be able to make a more informed decision about your retirement.
4. Once you have made your decision, please follow the instructions on the DROP Enrollment checklist or the Pension Retirement checklist, whichever is appropriate for you.
