

## Owner-Builder Online Permitting Instructions Modified Permitting Services

## **Owner-Builder Online Permitting Instructions**

In order to assist customers during the temporary closure to the public of the Orange County Administration Building and Permitting Services lobby, the Division of Building Safety has implemented a modified services procedure that enables owner-builders to obtain building permits online using <u>Orange County Fast Track Member Services</u>.

## Steps:

- 1. Take the <u>Fast Track Online Permitting and Plan Submittal</u> interactive training course. Owner-Builders may skip the Commercial section.
- 2. Set up a Fast Track Account as a non-license holder.
- 3. Apply for the permit online. In the "Description of Work" field, please indicate "Owner-Builder Permit to (enter a brief description of the work)". Example: "Owner-Builder Permit to construct a shed"
- 4. Upload required construction plans and documents adhering to requirements outlined in the training course.
- 5. Complete a video call to verify identity and submit an Owner-Builder Disclosure Statement. This process is outlined below.

## **Identity Verification and Submission of Owner-Builder Disclosure Statement**

Once you have completed steps 1-4 above, you are now ready to schedule a video meeting in order to complete identity verification and the Owner-Builder Disclosure Statement (Step 5). In order to proceed, you are required to have access to a device with a camera and microphone. Most modern cell phones and personal computers have the equipment necessary to join a Webex meeting.

- 1. Email <a href="mailto:OwnerVerification@ocfl.net">OwnerVerification@ocfl.net</a> to request a video meeting.
- 2. Include the following information in your email:
  - a. Permit number
  - b. Owner contact information: Name, address, and telephone number.
- 3. An Orange County Division of Building Safety representative will email you a Webex meeting invitation for the identity verification video meeting along with a copy of the Owner-Builder Disclosure Statement. print this document and have it available to complete during the video meeting. You must have valid state or federally-issued photo identification available during your video meeting.
- 4. Prior to issuance of the permit, the signed and verified owner-builder disclosure statement is required to be uploaded to the "other documents" link in FastTrack following the steps outlined by the interactive training course.
