ORDINANCE NO. 90-17

1  
2 AN ORDINANCE OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA  
3 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE  
4 CREATION OF AN ORANGE BLOSSOM TRAIL LOCAL  
5 GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

6 WHEREAS, Orange County, Florida (the "County") has  
7 authorized on August 6, 1990, the creation of Safe  
8 Neighborhood Improvement Districts in accordance with the  
9 Safe Neighborhood Act, Sections 163-501-163.522, Florida  
10 Statutes (the "Act"); and

11 WHEREAS, the City of Orlando, Florida (the "City") has  
12 authorized on October 3, 1988, the formation of Safe  
13 Neighborhood Improvement Districts in accordance with the  
14 Act; and

15 WHEREAS, the City and the County have entered into an  
16 Interlocal Agreement dated August 6, 1990 (the "Interlocal  
17 Agreement"), regarding the creation of a district pursuant to  
18 the Act the boundaries of which will overlap the  
19 jurisdictional boundaries of the City and the unincorporated  
20 area of the County.

21 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that an  
22 emergency exists sufficient to justify the enactment of this  
23 ordinance as an emergency ordinance pursuant to Section 210  
24 of the Orange County Charter.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
26 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA (the "Commission"):

27 Section 1. The boundaries and size of this district  
28 shall be as described in Exhibit "A". This district shall be  
29 called the Orange Blossom Trail Neighborhood Improvement  
30 District (the "District").

31 Section 2. The District is hereby authorized to revive a  
32 planning grant from the Department of Community Affairs.

33 Section 3. The District is authorized, pursuant to  
34 Section 163.506(1)(c), Florida Statutes, to levy an ad  
35 valorem tax on real and personal property of up to two mills  
36 annually. Said levy may be implemented only by unanimous  
vote of the board of directors of the District, as defined

1        Section 10.    The Board of County Commissioners hereby  
2 declares that an emergency exists as to the matters to be  
3 remedied by the enactment of this ordinance and this  
4 ordinance is therefore enacted as an emergency ordinance  
5 under Section 210 of the Orange County Charter. This  
6 ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and as approved  
7 by law and shall be of effective duration as limited by  
8 Section 210 of the Orange County Charter.
