






In what language do you write most fluently?







How concerned are you about businesses enforcing social distancing guidelines and other proper COVID-19 prevention health protocols (e.g., wearing masks/face coverings)?



How likely are you to dine at a restaurant in the next 3 to 4 weeks?




How likely are you to shop in a store in the next 3 to 4 weeks?






Are you more likely to shop in a store or dine at a restaurant that enforces a policy requiring all employees to wear masks/face coverings at all times?






Are you more likely to shop in a store or dine at a restaurant that enforces a policy requiring all employees <u>AND</u> patrons to wear masks/face coverings at all times?






Are you more likely to shop in a store or dine at a restaurant that conducts daily temperature checks of all employees?




Are you more likely to shop in a store or dine at a restaurant that conducts temperature checks of all employees <u>AND</u> patrons?






Would you attend a gathering of more than 50 people if all safety/health precautions were taken?







Would you attend a gathering of more than 100 people if all safety/health precautions were taken?




How do you think the general economic situation in Orange County has changed for you because of COVID-19? It has ...




In your opinion, your overall standard of living because of COVID-19 has...




How do you expect the general economic situation in Orange County to develop over the next 12 months? It will...



In your opinion, the number of people unemployed in Orange County over the next six months will...




In your opinion, prices for typical weekly purchases during the past two months have ...






