Summary of proposed ordinance (F.S. § 125.66(3)(a)1.):

The Orange County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) will conduct a public hearing regarding a proposed ordinance pertaining to the local provider participation fund in Orange County, Florida; amending chapter 25, article xi, of the Orange County code; amending section 25-330 (“purpose”) to allow for exemption of certain facilities from assessment; amending section 25-332 (“definitions”) to define two new terms to address exempt facilities by waiver and identifying authorized programs or arrangements; amending section 25-333 (“scope of assessment”) to align with state and federal requirements; amending section 25-334 (“computation of assessment”) to require an assessment based on state and federal requirements; amending chapter 25, section 25-339 (“adoption of assessment resolution and non-ad valorem assessment roll”) to allow for flexibility in the period for adoption of the assessment resolution; and providing for an effective date.
