Summary of proposed ordinance (F.S. § 125.66(3)(a)1.:

This ordinance amends section 38-1403 of Orange County Code to address the requirements of the recently passed legislation, Senate Bill 954, amending Section 397.487, Florida Statutes, which requires the County to adopt an ordinance establishing procedures for the review and approval of reasonable accommodation requests for "certified recovery residences" within its jurisdiction by January 1, 2026. The processes described within the amendment also apply to reasonable accommodation requests other than those for certified recovery residences.
