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Summary of proposed ordinance (F.S. § 125.66(3)(a)1.:

This ordinance creates a new Chapter 40 within the Orange County Code entitled the "Orange Code for Orange County, Florida" with the short title of "Orange Code", providing for consistency with the Comprehensive Plan, the establishment of new zoning districts, the adoption of a new official zoning map, and new or refined development-related processes, uses, standards, and regulations. This Ordinance will be considered in conjunction with the adoption of Comprehensive Plan Amendment 2023-1-C-CP-1 — An Evaluation and Appraisal-based Amendment updating the "Orange County Comprehensive Plan 2010-2030 - Destination 2030" and renaming it the "Vision 2050: Orange County Comprehensive Plan."
