Summary of proposed ordinance (F.S. § 125.66(3)(a)1.):

The proposed ordinance amends Ordinance No. 2025-15, which adopted the Vision 2050 Comprehensive Plan, to address subsequent changes in State law that prevented Vision 2050 from becoming effective as originally anticipated. The ordinance clarifies that Destination 2030 remains the County's operative Comprehensive Plan until the Vision 2050 Effective Date and establishes a temporary, voluntary procedure allowing certain eligible privately initiated applications to continue to be reviewed for comprehensive plan consistency under applicable Destination 2030 provisions. The ordinance does not amend the substantive provisions of Vision 2050 or any land development regulations and is intended to provide an orderly transition to Vision 2050 while allowing the Florida Department of Commerce to complete its statutory review of the Plan.
