

FLORIDA WILDLIFE COMMISSION (FWC)

- Use bear-resistant roll carts or secure your garbage
- Never feed bears or other wildlife
- Eliminate bird feeders or hang them at least 10 feet off the ground and 4 feet from the nearest tree
- Always clean barbecue grills and store in a secured structure after each use
- Always feed pets indoors
- Never leave garbage or food in vehicles
- Pick fruit from trees as soon as it becomes ripe and promptly remove fallen fruit from the ground

To be eligible for a discounted and approved bear-resistant roll cart, the applicant must:

- Be an Orange County Solid Waste residential curbside collection customer
- Provide proof of residence within the designated Bear Management Area

Benefits of Bear Carts

Solid Waste residential customers within the Bear Management Area:



Can set out garbage overnight instead of between 4 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Don't have to keep garbage roll carts in a secured location.

BE BEAR AWARE

Bears are drawn to neighborhoods when food sources, like garbage, are easy to find. Bear-resistant carts help discourage bears from making regular visits to neighborhoods.



What is a Bear Management Area?

A geographical region, designated by the Florida Wildlife Commission, with a significant number of bear/human interactions.
