YARD WASTE COLLECTION *Made Easy*

Hurricane season can bring a lot of uncertainty, but preparing your yard early can make a big difference. Follow these easy tips to help ensure safe, efficient yard waste collection service before and after a storm.



DON'T WAIT

Trim trees and remove dead branches before a storm is on the radar.



USE THE RIGHT CONTAINERS

- Bag leaves and grass clippings or use waterproof cans with lids and handles.
- Cans/bags must be 50 gallons or less and under 60 pounds.



KNOW YOUR LIMIT

Each household can set out up to 3 cubic yards per week – about the size of 3 stoves.



CUT STUMPS DOWN

- Ensure pieces are no longer than 3 feet.
- Keep each piece under 60 pounds.



BUNDLE PROPERLY

- Cut limbs and palm fronds to 3 feet or less and tie securely with string or twine.
- Keep each bundle under 60 pounds.



KEEP NEAT

- Do not mix yard waste with garbage, recyclables, or large items.
- Keep away from meters and utility boxes.

As a storm approaches, collection services could be temporarily suspended. Be sure to secure or remove any loose items or cans that could become airborne and projectiles. After a storm, expect curbside collection delays throughout the affected area. During cleanup, only storm debris set out according to yard waste guidelines (bagged, bundled, etc.) will be picked up with regular curbside collection. Large debris piles may be collected separately through a special storm recovery pickup program.

IT'S TO-GO TIME

Paper and Clear Plastic Cups Now Accepted in Recycling Carts

Cardboard cup sleeves are also welcome in recycling carts. Straws, lids, stirrers/stoppers, Styrofoam™, and colored party cups go in the garbage cart.

Cardboard Boxes: Recycling Cart or Large Item Pickup?

RECYCLING CART

Standard Size Delivery and Moving Boxes



ONLY cardboard boxes too large to fit in the recycling cart, even when broken down, should be set out on large item collection day.

LARGE ITEM PICKUP

Oversized Appliance and Furniture Boxes



DO NOT place cardboard boxes on top of the recycling or garbage carts.
