 - A description of sedimentation and erosion control measures used during construction.
 - Per direction from the BCC, riprap and native aquatic plantings shall be required for new and replacement seawalls with the exception of properties located on a canal where riprap may cause navigational concerns.
- A property survey or have the alteration areas drawn to scale on a survey.
- If project is for new seawall where no wall has existed and there is no wall on either adjacent property, the applicant must demonstrate that there is significant erosion and that a vertical seawall is the only practicable method available to stabilize the shoreline. To demonstrate this, a letter from a registered professional engineer shall be required.
