What we heard from the public:

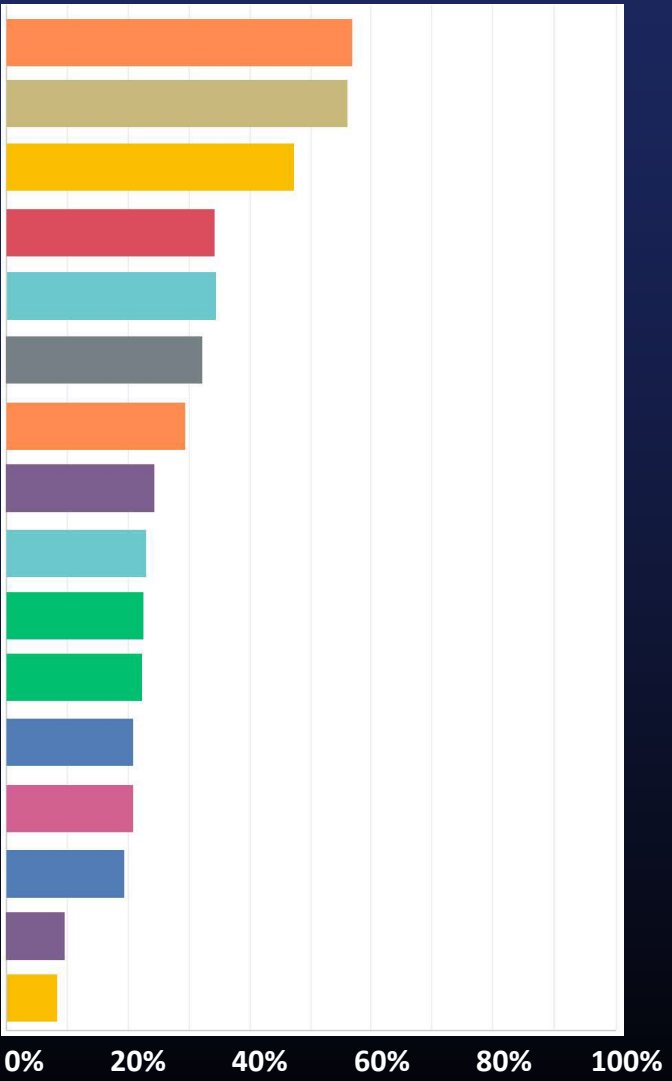
- Access from community

- Dog park and exercise amenities
- Splash pad
- Shade trees and walking paths with unstructured play

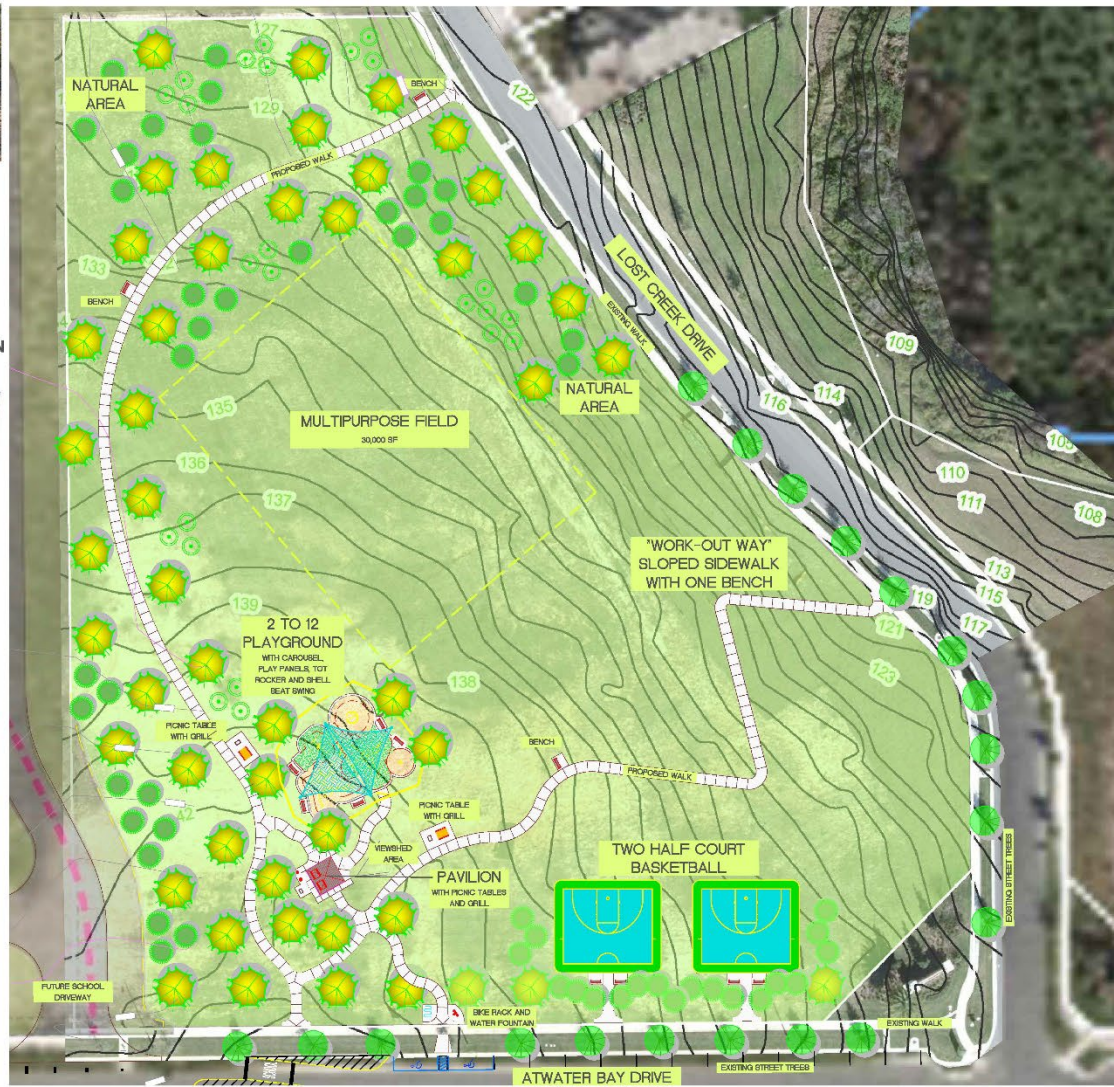

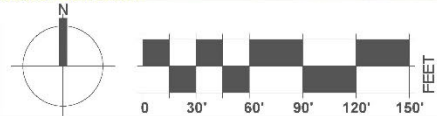

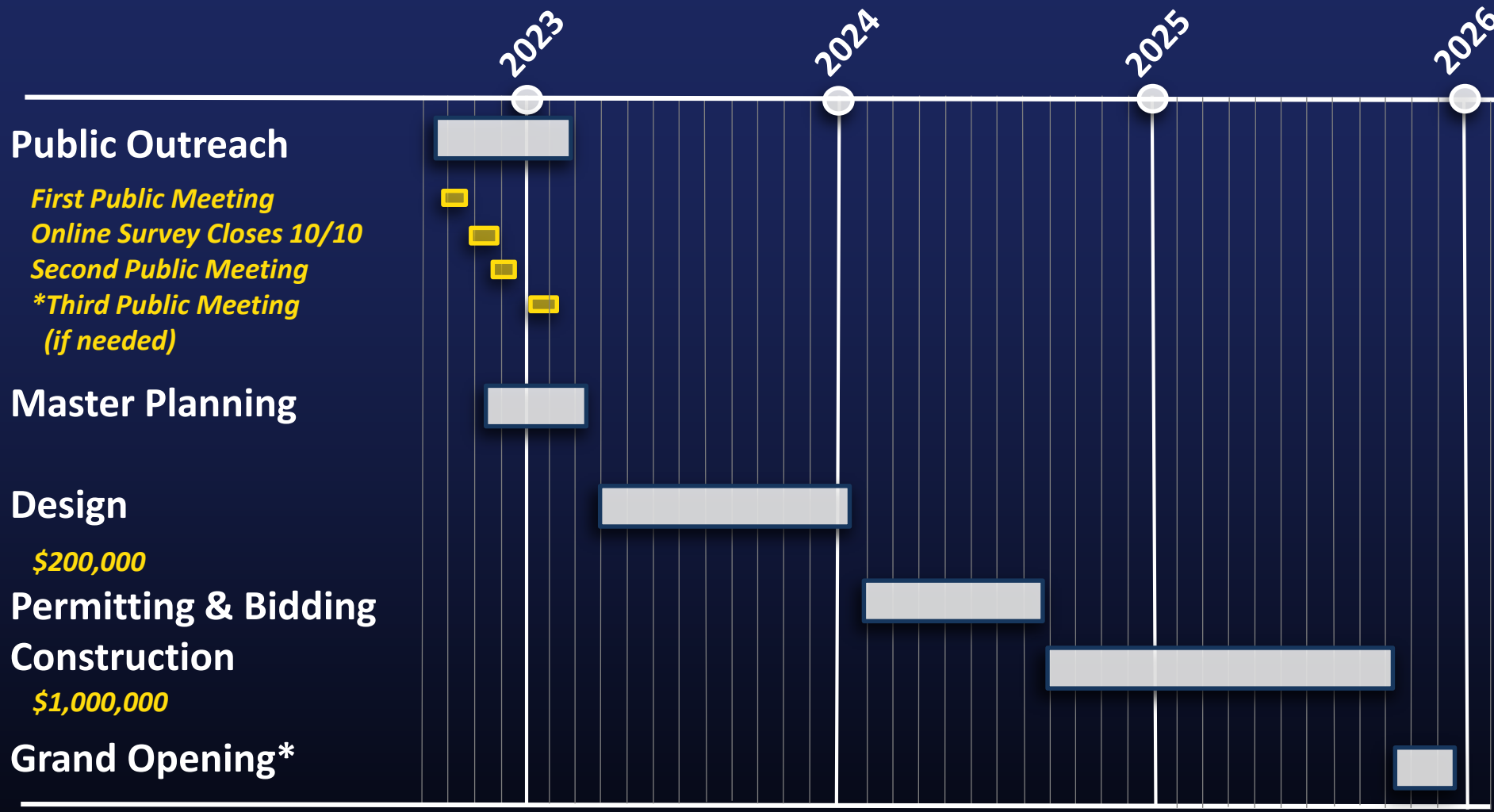


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Planning & Development Timeline
